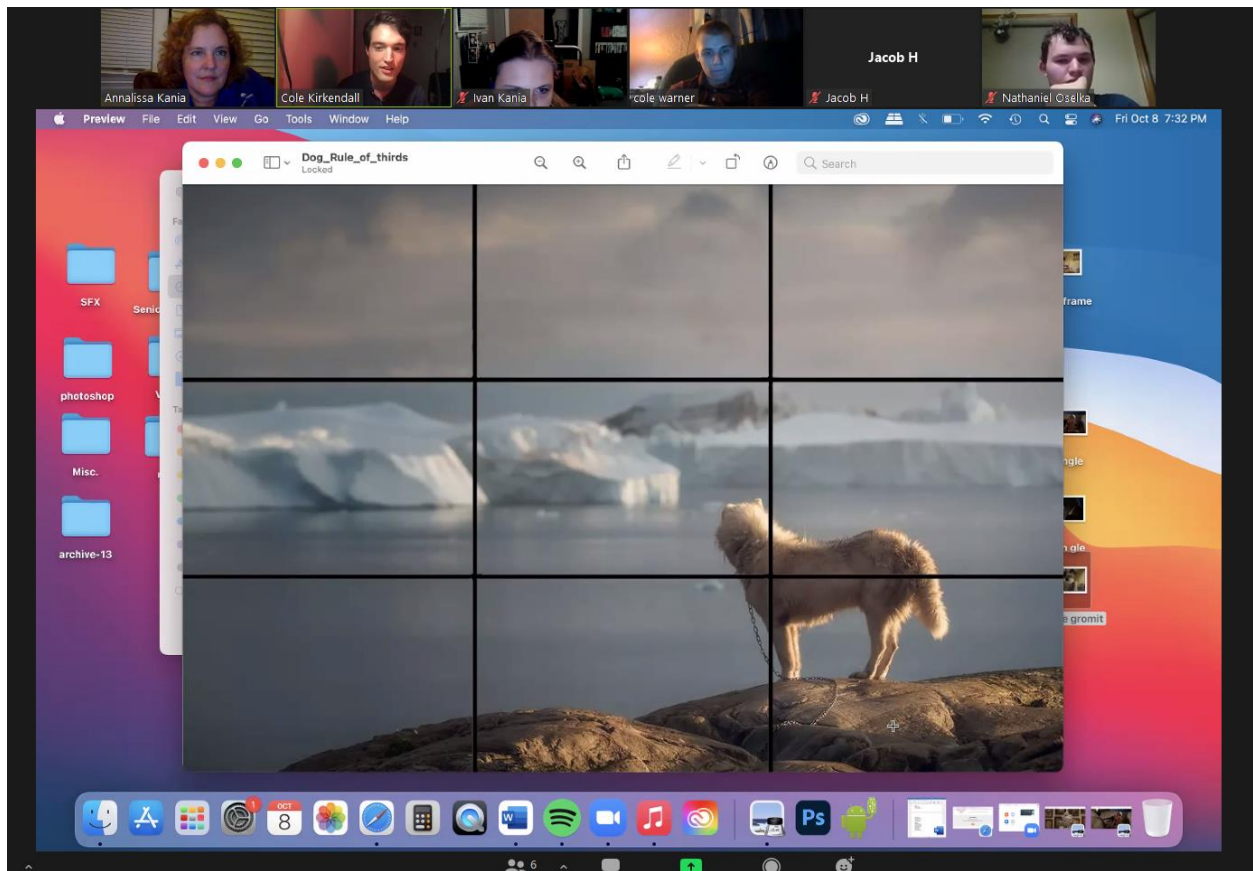


Camera tips to compose a shot:

Rule of 3: Right, middle, and left- often you can set grids on your camera to help.



Center frame- focus on main

When 2 characters involved- right stays slightly right in close ups to keep relation to main screen

Camera angles:

Scewed angles: creates a sense that something is confusing or off in the scene.

High angle- (the camera is looking down on the scene) the character appears weak

Low angle- (the camera is looking up on the scene) character has power, dominance

Lighting:

Shadow to heighten fear or Show dominance. Bright to show kind and friendly.
