Sensory Friendly COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic





Thedacare, the Building for Kids Children's Museum, Wisconsin Early Autism Project, and the Autism Society of Greater Wisconsin are partnering to offer a sensory friendly vaccine clinic with the goal of providing a positive, supportive, and calm vaccine experience. Participants can expect a lower sensory environment, sensory fidgets, distraction strategies, and other individualized accommodations as needed. After receiving their vaccine, participants can play in the museum. The Building for Kids will also provide a pizza dinner.

The clinic will offer Pfizer vaccines and boosters to eligible community members.

Every child under 12 who participates will receive a FREE 3-month family membership to the Building for Kids.
